Please read these guidelines carefully before submitting your piece to *Social Alternatives*.

### Submission

Contributions can be submitted by:

1. Where stories are submitted by mail, one copy should contain your name and contact details, as well as the article title. Two blind copies should contain only the article title and no identifying information.
2. Font should be 11-point Times New Roman.
3. Authors should provide a 50-word Bio-sketch. This should include your institutional affiliation. You may wish to include contact details and research interests.
4. Avoid using Style Headings and elaborate font changes as this will make things difficult for our desktop publisher.
5. Use single spaces after full stops. Avoid using the space bar to create more than 3 spaces. Use the ruler at the top.
6. Punctuation inside/outside quotation marks:
  - (a) if the quotation completes a sentence, then the full stop occurs inside the inverted comma;
  - (b) If not, the full stop goes outside the IC;
  - (c) Commas come before the IC where the sentence continues. *eg "All Newfoundlanders are intelligent," Svensson says, although acknowledging that his "ethnic identity may affect this judgment."*
